Dear

Following the announcement in Parliament on November 3<sup>rd</sup> 2022, that the UK will be opening negotiations with Mauritius about the future sovereignty of the Chagos Archipelago – and the future of the Chagossians – we are writing to inquire how Chagossians will be involved in these negotiations as it would appear that no Chagossian community group has yet been approached or consulted.

We write to you secure in the knowledge that the Chagossians are the ‘belongers’ on the Chagos Islands<sup>1</sup> (High Court, London 2000) and the indigenous inhabitants of that territory<sup>2</sup> (Pretoria Declaration 2022) and, as such, the forcibly exiled Chagossians and their descendants have a right to decide on matters related to the future of their territory which must be respected. We also note also that it is a longstanding UK Government policy that British Overseas Territories only exist with the explicit consent of their populations.<sup>3</sup> All Chagossians are British Overseas Territories citizens. Chagossians are also an African people, and we note (African Charter on Human and People’s Rights 1981) that “All peoples shall have the right to existence. They shall have the unquestionable and inalienable right to self-determination.”<sup>4</sup> We also draw your attention to the recent intervention by Human Rights Watch, which states that “consultation and participation of the Chagossian people....is crucial to these negotiations”<sup>5</sup>.

Chagossian Voices is a well-established and influential grassroots platform for Chagossians, communicating with thousands of Chagossians through our various online platforms. We look forward to a reply at your earliest convenience, and to the offer of a meeting with you to discuss how the involvement of the Chagossian community will be achieved.
